New York, NY- (March 16, 2011) The Forbes Galleries will exhibit award-winning artist Clark Hulings' paintings, giving a rare glimpse into the career of a distinguished American realist painter. The show encompasses oils, watercolors and drawings, from the last six decades of Hulings' life. The exhibition will run from Wednesday, March 22 to Saturday, September 10, 2011.

For more than 60 years Hulings traveled the back roads and byways of three continents, painting splendor where others might see misery. Hulings found inspiration for his paintings throughout North America and Europe, painting rural and urban landscapes that reflected the vibrancy of the human spirit. His celebration of textures brought urban alleyways and rustic farmers to life.
